Deluxe and Economy sleeping cars

Nothing beats a sleeping car for sheer comfort on board our City Night Line trains.

Groups of up to three people can reserve their own compartment so that everyone can look forward to their own bed at night – and breakfast in the morning.



Each sleeping compartment features a washbasin and is stocked with towels and toiletries. All sleeping cars have additional washing facilities with washbasins, showers, and WCs. Each Deluxe sleeping compartment features its own shower and WC for even greater convenience and privacy.

Couchette cars

Couchette compartments are the ideal option if you want to reserve an inexpensive berth for one to five people.



New: more room in couchette compartments! Maximum occupancy of couchette compartments is now five people, meaning the sixth berth remains unoccupied, providing you with more freedom of movement. If you would prefer more privacy and wish to travel in a group of fewer than five people, you have the option of booking an entire compartment.

Seating cars

Seating cars are the most affordable type of accommodation we offer. Depending on the route, you travel in a climate-controlled open-plan car or in a compartment with six places. Washing facilities and WCs are located in each car.

New: we've increased coach car capacity on several routes. Reservations are not required to use these coach services. They are designated as IC services in our booking system and in all timetable publications.

 On almost all routes, a wheelchair-accessible couchette compartment with special WC facilities is available for mobility-impaired passengers.
